Latest News and Updates on the LIFEx project

On the 4th of November, the project team had its first face-toface meeting at ÉCOLE headquarters in Milan having worked online for more of 2022. It was a great opportunity to meet all the team in person and we had a very productive meeting where we delved into the development of the Virtual Reality Learning experiences that we will create in 2023 as part of the

LIFEx project.

ISQe, our Portuguese partner, presented the development approach from both a technical and didactic perspective and talked all partners through the elaborate training methodology schematic they have created for the Virtual Reality (VR) Immersive Learning Experiences (ILx). We also used our time together to brainstorm and discuss the scenarios we will create for the ILx content to be used in the VR training sessions. For many of us, this is our first time to create new VR training experiences, so we left the meeting more confident in our ability to achieve our aims!

Finally, the meeting allowed us to conclude and launch **The LifeComp ILx Competence Profile** outlining the key competences for the LifeX project in each of the three key soft skill areas that we will focus on: Personal, Social and Learning to Learn. This competence profile will be a reference document for the rest of the project's development work as will help shape the structure and content of the VR experiences and associated assessment tools. Why Virtual Reality?

(VR) as our primary immersive learning tool as this method allows learners to not only be fully focused and engaged in the course, but also to take part through physical movement, immersing them fully in the learning experience!

The simulation of all senses in a controlled 3D environment allows the user to explore and interact in a virtual experience. For LifeX this should help learners develop their soft skills and increase their confidence in realistic realworld scenarios and be able to then transfer these new skills to their personal and professional lives.


